

Thank you for returning my call regarding Musical Moments, A Music Together program. It was a pleasure speaking with you.

As we discussed, I am trying to secure a location to get this program off the ground — up and running here on Guam. When I toured the space with Bonnie I noticed yourYoung Adult Study Room could be the perfect space.

Although I wouldn't plan to teach at your location long term, I was hoping for an opportunity to work with you for a little while (a semester or two) and am happy in return to give back to the community in the form of Scholarship Tuitions. If rental payment is an option or more appropriate, I would love to discuss term and fees. I am in the process of obtaining liability insurance for my program, but need to secure the location in order to do so.

I am hopingto begin by offering one summer semester at your location. That would entail using the space three mornings a week for two weeks. A total of six classes. Perhaps a Tues, Thurs, Sat or instead a Tues, Wed, Thurs schedule. The Summer Semester is a much shorter and more flexible session. Normally semesters run once a week for ten weeks. Fall, Winter and Spring.

I teach the Mixed Age Class which is appropriate for children ages birth through five, and children must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver. Class is 45 minutes of musical fun for all.

Normally my classes would have a maximum total of 25 people (12 of them being under the age of 5 years old). However, my minimum allowance for class is 6 Students which is 12total (6 adults and 6 children). I could cap my class at the minimum if that number is more appropriate for the space.

I am licensed to teachthe Music Togethers curriculum. I attended the Music Together Teacher Training in October of 2012 and received my Teacher Training Certification then. Music Togetheris a research-based, developmentally appropriate early childhood music curriculum that strongly emphasizes and facilitates adult involvement. I am very honored to be a part of this musical movement.

I started my own center, Music Together in the Canyon, shortly after obtaining my license. I held classes for seven semesters at our local Recreation Center in the South Rim Village of Grand Canyon, Arizona. Teaching this program has been an amazing learning experience for me and all those who attend. I can't wait to get started again. The families love the program, as do I.

I have added more details about the program below, as well as a Sample Lesson Plan for your information.

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The Music Together & Program

Music Together is an internationally recognized early childhood music program for infants, toddlers, preschoolers, and the adults who love them. First offered to the public in 1987, it pioneered the concept of a research-based, developmentally appropriate early childhood music curriculum that strongly emphasizes and facilitates adult involvement.

- It's a community of families sharing songs, instrument play, rhythm cliants, and movement activities in a relaxed, playful, non-performance-oriented setting.
- Music is learned through developmentally appropriate activities that support and respect the unique learning styles of very young children.
- Infants, toddlers and preschoolers participate at their own level in family-style classes of mixed ages.

Perhaps a Tues, Thurs, Sat or instead a Tues, Wed, Thurs schedule. The Summer Semester is a much shorter and more flexible session. Normally semesters run once a week for ten weeks. Fall, Winter and Spring.

I teach the Mixed Age Class which is appropriate for children ages birth through five, and children must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver. Class is 45 minutes of musical fun for all.

Normally my classes would have a maximum total of 25 people (12 of them being under the age of 5 years old). However, my minimum allowance for class is 6 Students which is 12total (6 adults and 6 children). I could cap my class at the minimum if that number is more appropriate for the space.

I am licensed to teach the Music Togethers curriculum. I attended the Music Together Teacher Training in October of 2012 and received my Teacher Training Certification then. Music Togetheris a research-based, developmentally appropriate early childhood music curriculum that strongly emphasizes and facilitates adult involvement. I am very honored to be a part of this musical movement.

I started my own center, Music Together in the Canyon, shortly after obtaining my license. I held classes for seven semesters at our local Recreation Center in the South Rim Village of Grand Canyon, Arizona. Teaching this program has been an amazing learning experience for me and all those who attend. I can't wait to get started again. The families love the program, as do I.

I have added more details about the program below, as well as a Sample Lesson Plan for your information.
