**Minutes of Meeting**

- I. **Call Meeting to Order.** The meeting was held at the Nieves M. Flores Memorial Library in Hagatna, Guam, and was called to order by Debra S. Duenas, Chairperson, on March 5, 2015 at 3:45pm.
- A. Roll Call
- Present:** Ms. Debra Duenas, Chairperson; Mr. Krishnan Seerengan, Vice-Chair; Denise Reyes, Board member; Kyle Mandapat, Treasurer; Sandra Stanley, Administrative Officer; and Frankie Aflague, Program Coordinator
- Absent:** Joseph Artero Cameron, President of DCA and Teresita LG Kennimer, Library Technician Supervisor.
- II. **Approval of Minutes.** Chairperson advises board that minutes were emailed to all members for their review. Motion was made by Kyle Mandapat to accept board minutes from January 15, 2015 with second motion made by Denise Reyes; all in favor with unanimous acceptance of minutes. Chairperson approves the minutes with June Aflague countersigning.
- III. **Reports.** Ms. Sandra Stanley, Administrative Officer distributed to all board members and reported as follows:
- 70TON Unit - requisition is still with GSA which is going through the procurement process.
  - DOI Project – Contractor is still pending clearances and permit issuance from the Department of Parks & Recreation.
  - Dededo Branch renovation – Project has officially begun as of March 3, 2015.
  - Recruitment for building custodian – Hiring of one additional custodian to fill a vacancy.
  - Arts in Public Building – Meeting with CAHA is scheduled for Friday, March 13<sup>th</sup> at the GPLS Conference room. Members have on their agenda.
  - FY2016 Budget – all members were provided in their packet a copy of the FY2016 Budget. GPLS ceiling amount is \$1,535,478.00.
- Kyle asks if budget includes funding for the position of Territorial Librarian.  
Sandra Stanley replied that position is funded under a different public law under the Territorial Education Facilities Fund (TEFF), Special funding. There is a separate staffing pattern in our budget for that position.*
- Email from Legal Counsel - It has been clarified by legal counsel at the Governor's office that board chair is allowed to vote in order to meet quorum.

**Programs.** Frankie Aflague spoke on GPLS programs.

- New children's program beginning next week. Has been in planning for almost a year. The new program is called Bilingual Literacy through the Community. Program will be held twice a month. The children involved in this program are those with special needs. They will be taking a field trip from their school to the library. Reading is done with the translators.
- Another big event coming up is Dr. Seuss' birthday party on March 8, 2015. GPLS is in collaboration with the University of Guam in assisting with Saturday's event.
- Chamorro month - GPLS is in collaboration with Tony Ramirez, Department of Parks and Recreation and CAHA.
- Library Week starts on April 13<sup>th</sup> thru April 17<sup>th</sup>. Currently working with the Governor's office on the Proclamation signing and GPLS will be having an awards ceremony recognizing its sponsors and employees.

#### IV. Old Business

1. **Friends of the Library (Non-profit).** A draft was prepared by Kyle Mandapat and Chairperson says that all members are to review and dedicate themselves to a working session to finalize the by-laws.
2. **Volunteer Programs.** The CWEP (Community Work Experience Program) applications that Board member Denise gave to Ms. Sandra Stanley and Ms. Teresita Kennimer were completed and emailed to the Department of Public Health for the positions of Clerk/Typist and Building Custodian. They both were able to meet with Patricia Mafnas from Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPH&SS) on February 11, 2015 and go over the details in regards to the program. Board Chair has offered to assist the department in contacting Ms. Mafnas to help expedite our request.

*Mr. Kris Seerengan, member arrives.*

3. **Job Description.** Board chair, Ms. Debra asks Ms. Sandra Stanley, Administrative Officer to explain to the rest of the members the reason for the delay in the recruitment of Territorial Librarian.

Mr. Cameron wants me to prepare immediately for his signature the Personnel Action (GG-1) for the Territorial Librarian. However, these are the problems:

- Because of the Reorganization that is currently in place, the department cannot have a Director or a Territorial Librarian because Mr. Cameron is the President. The Re-org eliminated the Director position for the library. And per the public law, it cannot read "Territorial" in the position. The law must be amended to read for example...Managing Library Administrator.
- Funding is no longer available to fund the position.
- It is per the recommendation from the Department of Administration (HR), that since we cannot hire for a Territorial Librarian or Director because of the Re-org, they recommend GPLS hire in *lieu of* the positions that the department hire maybe three or

four librarians. However, the public law specifically states the money is strictly for a Territorial Librarian.

*Mr. Kris Seerengan suggests that the board seek counseling from the Library Association in the mainland because there is a requirement of certification specifications for a library.*

*Board Chair, recommends that we do not do even go there with that. Mr. Cameron wants us to put the GG-1 thru so we should send it and if it gets rejected then we can say we tried.*

*Ms. Sandra Stanley says she cannot certify a GG-1 if there is no funding. It is against the law. Board agrees with her and that the law must be followed. At this point, she does not know what to do anymore about it.*

*Mr. Kris asks, what is it going to take to get this position funded?*

*Mr. Kyle Mandapat says, maybe the board should meet with the Governor.*

*Board Chair says, Mr. Cameron has mentioned that the Governor wants to talk to this board. The President needs to follow his word and arrange for all this to happen. We need to move forward and get some sort of direction with the Governor in regards to recruiting the position.*

*Mr. Kris makes a motion to for our President to arrange a meeting with all board members to meet with Governor. Mr. Kyle Mandapat, seconds the motion.*

**4. Board Manual.** Board manual is still being reviewed. All members have a working electronic copy. They all agree a working session must take place on this matter.

#### **V. New Business.**

- Annual Financial Disclosure Statement to the Guam Election Commission is in packet for all members to complete and submit no later than April 22, 2015.

#### **VI. Open Discussion.**

##### **Public Speaking**

Omaira Brunal Perry:

Her concern that she brought up to board is in regards to when will the position of Archivist for the Library be filled. Says that the Island of Guam is missing a lot of opportunities with the position being vacant.

Board chair, agrees with her that we definitely need an archivist. If GPLS has a Territorial Librarian and Archivist on board, the department would have access to a variety of grants and federal programs.


Antonio Perry:

**Next Meeting.** All members agree to their next meeting on Thursday, March 26, 2015.


