PUBLIC ANNOUCEMENT OPENING OF SECTION 8 WAITING LIST

The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) hereby give notice that in accordance with regulations of the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), and GHURA's Section 8 Administrative Plan, it will temporarily reopen its Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) Program waiting list for the purpose of re-establishing a waiting list through a lottery system.

Applications for the lottery may be accessed starting Monday, 8 am, October 1, 2018 and through Friday, 5 pm, October 5, 2018. **LOTTERY APPLICATIONS WILL BE AVAILABLE ONLINE ONLY at www.ghura.org. NO HARDCOPY ENTRY WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Those interested are encouraged to enter the lottery using their home computer, smart phone, or tablet, or wherever internet is available. For those without a computer or internet access or those requiring assistance in submitting an application, you may come to the GHURA main office at 117 Bien Venida, Sinajana or one of the following sites:

Who may apply? Families who meet the income limit designated for their household size below are encouraged to apply:

Everyone who applies will have an equal chance of being randomly selected for the waiting list. Where and when you apply will not make a difference or improve your odds of being selected. A total of 1,800 applicants will be randomly drawn and slotted by the computer to re-establish the 2018 Section 8 waiting list. Only those selected will be notified in writing of their selection. Those not selected will have to re-apply at the next wait list opening.

Multiple entries from the same household **will not be accepted**. All entries must be completed and successfully submitted to receive a lottery number. Applicants must maintain their lottery numbers for future verification.
