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AN ACT TO ADD NEW SECTIONS 4202.1 AND 4202.2 TO TITLE 4 GCA TO REQUIRE GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES WHO ARE CHARGED WITH OR CONVICTED OF A CRIME TO PROVIDE PROMPT NOTICE OF THE CHARGES OR CONVICTION TO THE HEAD OF THE EMPLOYEE'S DEPARTMENT OR AGENCY AND TO PROVIDE SANCTIONS FOR FAILURE TO PROVIDE NOTICE.

## 1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 **Section 1.** A new Section 4202.1 is hereby *added* to Title 4 GCA to
- 3 read:
- 4 "§4202.1. Duty to Report Criminal Charges or
- 5 **Conviction.** An employee in the classified service who is charged by

1	indictment, information or magistrate's complaint with any crime in
2	any court or who is convicted of a crime in any court except Traffic
3	Court shall provide the head of the department or agency employing
4	the employee with written notice of the charges or the conviction
5	within seventy-two (72) hours thereof."

Section 2. A new Section 4202.2 is hereby *added* to Title 4 GCA to read:

## **"§4202.2.** Failure to Report Criminal Charges or Conviction.

- (a) Failure to provide the notice required by Title 4 GCA §4202.1 is grounds for a separate Adverse Action.
- (b) The sixty (60) day limitation imposed by Title 4 GCA §4406 commences when the employee gives notice of the charges or conviction of a crime to the head of the department or agency as required by Title 4 GCA §4202.1."
- **Section 3**. **Effective Date**. This Act shall take effect thirty (30) days after its enactment. *I Maga'lahen Guåhan* shall, prior to the effective date of this Act, provide a public notice of the contents of Sections 1 and 2.
