Citation Indexes
Introduction

This index to the 1977 Pacific Daily News was prepared by the staff of the Nieves Flores Memorial Library. It is designed to assist researchers, students and others to locate subjects of interest on Guam and Micronesia. 1977 is the only year which has been indexed to date. Other years which has been indexed to date? Other years will be published as they are completed.

The index is arranged alphabetically by subjects. It is not intended to be a complete index since it covers only news papers about Guam, Micronesia and the Pacific area. Guam is most fully indexed.

If the users know the name of the person, place or topic, (she/he) will find this as a subject heading in the index. The headings are cross referenced. For each article, the title, volume, month, day, page and column are indicated. Common abbreviations are used. Obituaries are listed alphabetically by name under the subject heading. Article titles are often altered to give content information.

Examples of format:

Weather

Storm causes damage (illus)

P VIII; 9/15 p3 c1

Weather - Subject

Storm causes damage – Title of article

(illus) – Photo or Sketch

PDN – Pacific Daily News

VIII; - Volume number

9 – Month

15 – Day

P3 – page number

c1 – column
