Minutes of Meeting

- I. Call Meeting to Order.** The meeting was held at the Guam Public Library System (GPLS) Main library and was called to order to by Mr. Kyle Mandapat, Chairman of the Board on February 8, 2018 at 4:16 p.m.

A. Roll Call

Present: Mr. Kyle Mandapat; Mr. William Sarmiento, Vice Chairman; Mr. Krishnan Seerengan, Secretary/Treasurer; Mrs. Marissa Mears, Member-at-Large; Mr. Johnny Sablan, President, Department of Chamorro Affairs.

II. Approval of Meeting Minutes of January 11, 2018 GPLS Board meeting

Chairman Mandapat stated that the board meeting minutes of January 11, 2018 were emailed to each member. Mr. Sarmiento motioned to approve the minutes and Mrs. Marissa Mears seconded the motion. All were in favor of approving the minutes.

III. Reports

- 1. Administrative Officer's Report.** Chairman Mandapat called on GPLS Administrative Officer, Mrs. Sandra Stanley to discuss her report.

Mrs. Stanley spoke that the recruitment GG1s for Library Technician I & II positions have been with the Department of Administration (DOA) since January 11, 2018. Mrs. Stanley adds that the latest correspondence she had with DOA was that these GG1s are on hold due to the priority of hiring law enforcement positions.

Mrs. Stanley also spoke that she had provided in each board member packet, BBMR Circular No. 18-05, Executive order No. 2012-01 and BBMR Circular No. 18-04 regarding General Fund reduction. Chairman Mandapat states the board will review the attachments.

- 2. Library Technician Supervisor's Reports.** Chairman Mandapat called on GPLS Library Technician Supervisor, Mrs. Teresita Kennimer to discuss Library Technician Supervisor Report

Mrs. Kennimer stated that her reports provided in each board member packet are regarding the statistics for attendance, circulation and book deposits for Hagatna and Branch libraries. Everything remains the same regarding the services to occupants and all libraries.

Mrs. Kennimer also mentioned that GPLS will be starting book sales that will start the week of National Library Week beginning that Wednesday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and on Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. Right now, Mrs. Kennimer is accepting new and used good books to sort out and decide which ones to sell and which ones to keep. Mrs. Kennimer added that attached to her report is a flyer of the book sale and asked to pass the word out for a successful sell. Chairman Mandapat requested for a digital copy of the flyer to be sent out electronically.

Mrs. Kennimer added that whatever books were not sold, GPLS normally would call the Ayuda Foundation to pick them up because they do also service the outer islands. She has also received some calls from some of the communal association regarding the left over books that were not sold. Mrs. Kennimer mentioned that half of the books would be distributed to our branch libraries to sell. The revenue from these sells would go into the account for fines and fees. Vice Chairman Sarmiento asked if GPLS ever gets textbooks from the schools. Mrs. Kennimer stated that when GPLS does get textbooks from the university and high schools, a lot of the sales come from selling them. Mrs. Kennimer added that books do also come from the Navy. As far as Elementary and Middle School, there are not much books that do come in.

Vice Chairman Sarmiento asked for whatever books that GPLS does not sell, could we consider thinking about starting with giving the books to the primary aged children at the public schools. Mrs. Kennimer mentioned that when the branches do sort out the books that GPLS does not need, they do contact the schools and the village mayors come by and pick up the books for the village public schools to have.

IV. Old Business:

1. Internet Café Rules and Regulations. Board to adopt and approve.

Chairman Mandapat mentioned that the board has had previous discussions regarding the internet café; having a minimum of \$600.00 rented and the liabilities that the vendor will be responsible for such as the utilities.

Mr. Sablan mentioned that the rules and regulations attached are pretty reasonable and functional and that if the board does accept it, it would be subject to minor modifications such as trash fees.

2. Vendor rental responsibilities.

Mr. Seerengan brought up his concern for the internet connection that on the stipulations, the vendor should provide their own internet connection. GPLS may get connection interruption and that it should be stipulated and clear in the rules and regulations that the vendor will not be allowed to have access to GPLS connection.

Motion to adopt the internet café rules and regulations presented to the board with the inclusion of the modification of the use of the internet connection was made by Mr. Seerengan and seconded by Mr. Sarmiento.

- 3. Mrs. Avantyr sent an email on January 25, 2018 cancelling the demo for Saturday, January 27, 2018.**

Mrs. Avantyr had to cancel her Musical Moments demo due to the relocation of her and her husband. Mrs. Stanley relayed that Mrs. Avantyr thanked the board for allowing her the opportunity to consider her doing a demonstration.

- 4. EBSCO is now available to patrons with Mr. Krishnan Seerengan's assistance.**

With the assistance of Mr. Seerengan, GPLS patrons are now able to access EBSCO for free. Mr. Seerengan stated that he would like to mention in today's meeting that in his discussion with Mrs. Kennimer and Mrs. Stanley. Guam Department of Education (GDOE) has a system that they have had for a few years and he wishes that GPLS can do the same thing and integrate with some of the schools. The system offers a search of all the libraries for a book where if an individual is looking for a certain book, they can extend their search to the other (40) libraries. Mrs. Stanley mentioned that the issue had been rectified with data. Mr. Seerengan demonstrated that it was difficult for him to do the search on the GPLS website. Mr. Seerengan and Chairman Mandapat requested for data to maybe put a link at the top of the GPLS website to be able to perform this search and to be more user friendly.

Mr. Seerengan asked how much per year is GPLS paying for the Horizon system. Mrs. Stanley stated \$20,000.00. Mr. Seerengan stated that GDOE only pays about \$500.00 a year for their system. Chairman Mandapat suggested that Mr. Seerengan does some research on the possibility of transitioning to a different system launched that will work for GPLS. Mr. Sarmiento made a motion to authorize Mr. Seerengan to do the research for GPLS to transition its Horizon system to another system that can be offered to GPLS as far as upgrading, making the system more user-friendly and to be more modernized than the current GPLS system, Horizon. Mrs. Mears seconded the motion.

- 5. Chairman Mandapat to contact PDN and possibly partnering with GPLS to provide free services.**

PDN and The Post E-edition is now free to GPLS and the format is in PDF format that can be either forwarded via email or other branches can log in. These, however are not indexed. Mrs. Kennimer asked if this is where News Bank comes in and Chairman Mandapat stated yes. Chairman Mandapat to provide Mrs. Kennimer with Point of Contact information for PDN.

- 6. Possibly erecting a perimeter fence at GPLS large parking lot.**

Chairman Mandapat brought up the subject of possibly erecting a perimeter fence around the GPLS parking lot. Mr. Sablan stated that the first thing that needs to be taken a look at is our map to have our surveyor accurately identify our boundaries in order to set up the chain link fence at the Hagatna Library. Mrs. Stanley mentioned that GPLS will draft a letter from Mr. Sablan to the Director of Department of Land Management to request for their services. Once GPLS identifies the markers and the board decides that they would like to put up a chain link, then everything will be set up.

V. Open Discussions:

Mr. Sablan mentioned that there are (2) private organizations that approached him about having a public-private partnership to be able to open up the libraries for more than just (1) day a week. These private organizations were interested in partnering up with the Agat and Barrigada branches. Mr. Sablan mentioned that a matter of discussion of what is required and board approval is needed for GPLS to move ahead and research to find out if GPLS would have to go to the legislature to be able to enter a public-private organization. Mr. Seerengan added that this would be good because he has come across some of his students from the University of Guam that ask what is the purpose of opening a branch library only once a week.

Mr. Sablan mentioned that once the private organizations receive a formal letter then GPLS/the board can entertain discussing the possibility of opening the branch libraries to discuss/ negotiate opening the remaining (5) days. Mr. Sablan also added that with the cutbacks this year, this would be a great strategic plan. Mr. Sablan also added that with the young generation who are very technology savvy, we need to modify some things and provide them with the technology that they need and then they would want to come in to the library for resources; however we can still keep the traditional way. Mr. Sablan mentioned that having another bookmobile could be the next strategic plan. Chairman Mandapat asked if GPLS has a bookmobile. Mrs. Stanley mentioned that the GPLS bookmobile has been down the last (4) years and is at Matson. Just to repair the air conditioners, it will cost over \$100,000.00. Mr. Sablan mentioned that Matson appears to be a good sponsor and maybe considering for them to be a sponsor to purchase another bookmobile. Mr. Seerengan mentioned that the public schools have labs with computers where the teachers reserve the lab to come by and use it. The computers are also protected for the children. Mr. Sablan stated that he thinks that we should establish a strategic plan to see if GPLS wants something like this. Mr. Sarmiento added that we need to step out of the box and one of the things that he thinks will work is if GPLS can have something where the students can get electronic textbooks by signing in through the GPLS website.

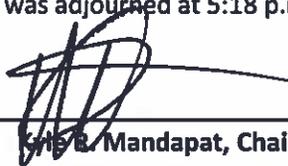
Chairman Mandapat recommended that Board Meetings will be held every 2nd Thursday of the month which the members agreed upon.

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2018-03

**RELATIVE TO IMPLEMENTING A 32-HOUR WORK WEEK
FOR ALL EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCIES THAT ARE
FUNDED OR PARTIALLY FUNDED BY THE GENERAL FUND**

WHEREAS, on December 22, 2017, President Donald Trump signed a new national tax reform plan, the *Tax Cuts and Jobs Act* [H.R.1 - AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR RECONCILIATION PURSUANT TO TITLES II AND V OF THE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION ON THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018], into law as U.S. P.L. No. 115-97; and

WHEREAS, P.L. No. 115-97 amends the Internal Revenue Code to lower income tax rates, including the lowering of private corporate tax rates to about 50% or less, and to provide for the modification of certain existing tax credits, deductions, and policies; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that under the new national tax reform plan, the Government of Guam may not be able to collect approximately \$67 million or more in revenue, thus significantly affecting government operations and the ability to provide critically necessary services related to health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, despite days of session to consider and plan for the inevitable impact to government operations, including the establishment of a dedicated funding source to preserve and sustain the Guam Memorial Hospital, the 34th Guam Legislature failed to take any meaningful action to resolve the looming financial crisis; and



WHEREAS, it is critical that aggressive austerity measures be immediately undertaken in order to stabilize and safeguard the government and the island community as a result of the severe financial shortfall; and

WHEREAS, Section § 1422 of the Organic Act of Guam (Title 48, United States Code) provides that the executive power of Guam is vested in the Governor of Guam "who shall have general supervision and control of all the departments, bureaus, agencies, and other instrumentalities of the executive branch of the government of Guam."

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDDIE BAZA CALVO, Governor of Guam, by the authority vested in me by the Organic Act and laws of Guam, do hereby order and direct as follows:

(1) **Mandatory 32-Hour Work Week.** Effective Tuesday, March 6, 2018, and subject to the following terms and conditions, a mandatory thirty-two (32) hour work week is implemented for all Executive Branch departments, agencies, and offices that are funded or partially funded by the General Fund:

- (a) Such reduction of hours shall not exceed nor be less than eight (8) hours per week.
- (b) No full-time employee whose hours are reduced will lose any benefits the employee received prior to the implementation of the reduction of the work week hours.
- (c) The change shall not affect the employee's accrual of years of service for the purposes of retirement.

(2) **Department and Agency Heads to Determine Work Schedules.** The head of each department, agency and office affected by this Executive Order shall review and coordinate the schedules of their respective employees and make the necessary adjustments to comply with this Executive Order while minimizing disruptions in service.

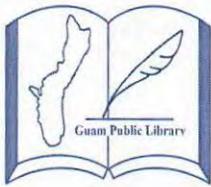

Buenas! Mrs. Glenda Perez contacted me on Thursday, February 15, 2018 with the following remarks:

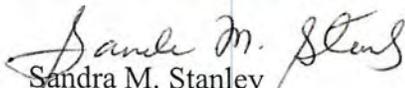
1. A mango tree situated on our property is a safety hazard to her and her family. The tree is actually dead and the branches might fall and hurt her grandchildren; and
