- I. **CALL TO ORDER.** Board meeting of the GPLS held on Friday, August 26, 2022 at 4:20 pm, by Chairman, Jeremy Cepeda via zoom.
- II. **ROLL CALL.** Mr. Jeremy Cepeda, Chairman; Dr. Monique Storie, Treasurer; Ms. Nicole Nelson, Dr. Matilda Rivera and Mr. William “Nan” Li.

- III. **APPROVAL OF MINUTES** – Meeting of Friday, July 29, 2022

IV. DIRECTOR’S REPORT

- a) Travel report on the ALA conference provided to members via email. He is currently waiting on the shipment for the \$2000 worth of books from the Library of Congress to come in. Spoke briefly regarding a letter he received from Senator Perez regarding amending a procurement matter that will help GPLS.
- b) Internet Café Resolution provided to members via email. Once the board approves of it is when it will be routed to GSA.

DR. STORIE

1. What types of professional training or development are you going to present to the library technicians based on your recent travel and experience with ALA and what have you scheduled yet?

DIRECTOR SEERENGAN

The challenges we have right now are library technicians who are getting close to retirement. I don’t see much enthusiasm and maybe the younger generation that we recently hired can attend the training than the folks that are close to retiring.

DR. STORIE

Strongly cautions against saying those considering retirement are unenthusiastic. It just means that you have not found the right training for them. Have you asked them what kind of training they would be interested in? I would like to see a scheduled training for the technicians which is something both you and I spoke about before you assumed the director position here at GPLS, and now that you have been here for over a year as the director what is it that you want to do for training?

V. OLD BUSINESS

- b. Five-Year Strategic Plan. Per Chairman discussion will be tabled to provide more time necessary to put together a working committee

JEREMY CEPEDA

A method was discussed on the process for the Director's evaluation which will be a self-evaluation and will be decided by a committee that is selected. An example is on how goals were met and to identify from his perspective on improvements. In addition, the committee will conduct a sit-down interview.

DIRECTOR SEERENGAN

One of the biggest problems here at the library is that we are not meeting the protocol with the board members entertaining complaints from the staff. As professionals the board should bring it to the Director's attention instead of entertaining the staff. That is not acceptable. My door is open all the time and if I am doing anything wrong then tell me. I hear my subordinates are calling the board. This is just a policy board and you cannot be interfering in operation and micro managing. Yes, there is a law that requires evaluation for Director's but I've only been here for one year. I am trying to fix a lot of things going on. I know there is a lot of resentment and I'm getting a lot of resistance. The board needs to support me instead of listening to the staff. I am ready for any kind of evaluation and I am not afraid.

JEREMY CEPEDA

We cannot speak for what the other agencies are doing and our only concern is following the law specifically for the library which states after one year the Director of the library must be evaluated. Advises Director Seerengan that he cannot stop the employees from reaching out

to the board and are not taking the employees word over his. The evaluation method will be a self-evaluation which gives the Director a fair process. Three members have been selected to sit on the committee pending their acceptance.

DR. RIVERA

Invites the board to join the upcoming story hour on September 3rd, and Thanks the Director and member Ms. Nicole Nelson for their participation and support.

JEREMY CEPEDA

Announces that he will be resigning and stepping down from his role on the GPLS board. Thanks the members and the Director for the opportunity.

IX. NEXT BOARD MEETING

Members agree to postpone until after the closing of the fiscal year to hold the next meeting sometime in October.

X. ADJOURNMENT

Meeting adjourns at 5:48 pm. Motion made to adjourn the meeting as follows:




NOTE:

Dr. Rivera approves motion, and Mary Mears seconds.







3 *I Liheslatura* further finds that it is important that modernization of our library
4 system requires procurement of the latest books, journals, research databases, and
5 access to digital publications; and many of the providers are off-island vendors that
6 do not accept Government of Guam purchase orders and require advance payment
7 before its provision of goods or services.

8 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*, therefore, intends to provide the Guam Public Library
9 System with greater flexibility to expeditiously acquire the tools they need to expand
10 its offerings to the community, and to authorize the use of advanced payment for the
11 procurement only for library books, e-books, audiobooks, digital publications,
12 newsletters, software, and any other publications deemed necessary.

13 **Section 2.** § 5007 of Subarticle A, Article 1, Chapter 5, Title 5, Guam Code
14 Annotated, is hereby *amended* to read as follows:

15 **“§ 5007. Policy Against Advance Payments.**







AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 80129 TO CHAPTER 80 OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE ACQUISITION OF LIBRARY BOOKS, E-BOOKS, AUDIOBOOKS, DIGITAL PUBLICATIONS, NEWSLETTERS, SOFTWARE, AND ANY OTHER PUBLICATIONS DEEMED NECESSARY BY THE GUAM PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** A new § 80129 is hereby *added* to Chapter 80 of Title 5, Guam

3 Code Annotated, to read as follows:

1 **“§ 80129. Acquisition of Library Books, E-Books, Audiobooks,**
2 **Digital Publications, Newsletters, Software, and Any Other Publications**
3 **Deemed Necessary.**

4 The Guam Public Library System is authorized to determine what
5 library books, e-books, audiobooks, digital publications, newsletters,
6 software, or other publications are needed to meet the mandates and needs of
7 the Public Library with approval from the Guam Public Library Board. Once
8 approved by the Guam Public Library Board, this list shall be sent to the
9 General Services Agency for processing and acquisition.”

10 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE GUAM PUBLIC LIBRARY SYSTEM
AND
THE BOOKMOBILE FOUNDATION OF GUAM**

THIS AGREEMENT is entered into this _____ day of _____, 2023, by and between the Guam Public Library System whose address is 254 Martyr Street, Hagåtña, Guam 96910, hereinafter called “GPLS” and the Bookmobile Foundation of Guam, whose address is 520 Chorito Boulevard, Suite 301, Asan, Guam 96910, hereinafter called the “Foundation”.

WHEREAS, Bookmobiles strive to make connections between the GPLS, the community, and the patrons; and

WHEREAS, as technology continues to advance, the bookmobile library will continue to develop new services and incorporate new methods for reaching patrons especially in communities of Guam where access to library services is not available; and

WHEREAS, the Bookmobile service intends to enhance engagement of everyone with the goal of providing access to every woman, man and child regardless of social station, ethnicity, sexual orientation, education level or any other socially constructed label; and

WHEREAS, the Bookmobile service is made possible as a public service for the people of Guam and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to outline the responsibilities associated with the Bookmobile operations and services between GPLS and the Foundation; and

NOW THEREFORE, GPLS and the Foundation in consideration of mutual covenants hereinafter set forth, agree as follows:

THE FOUNDATION AGREES to:

MATSON will take the lead role in representing the Bookmobile Foundation for all business transactions. Foundation will ensure the items listed are accomplished. **MATSON** further agrees to provide preventive maintenance and upkeep of the bookmobile bus.

CABRAS MARINE has designed and retrofitted the bus for its Library Service operations. Cabras Marine will further provide maintenance and upkeep of the retrofit work that was performed, as required.

GUAM TELEPHONE AUTHORITY will outfit the bookmobile with all the necessary Wi-Fi/technical services and upkeep;

SOUTH PACIFIC PETROLEUM CORPORATION will provide the fuel for the bookmobile bus.

PACIFIC DAILY NEWS and **KUAM** will provide all promotional advertising and the schedules of the bookmobile services. Both further agree to provide any other advertising needed that are directly associated with the operations and services of the bookmobile.

RUDER INTEGRATED MARKETING STRATEGIES will do the graphic design and branding of the interior and exterior look of the Bookmobile and upkeep, as needed.

GPLS AGREES to:

- A. Provide the personnel staffing and funding costs of:
 - 1. One (1) full-time and one (1) alternate Library Technician; and
 - 2. One (1) full-time and one (1) alternate Bookmobile Driver
- B. Provide all the administrative supplies and equipment needed to outfit the Bookmobile for its Library services and operations
- C. Obtain annual vehicle registration for bookmobile service for Guam

BOTH THE GPLS BOARD AND FOUNDATION AGREE TO:

Plan and sponsor fundraisers as needed to improve, support and sustain the Bookmobile Service for Guam.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT:

This MOU will be reviewed and assessed annually for modifications and updating as agreed upon by GPLS and the Foundation.

I. GENERAL COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS:

1. GPLS and the Foundation shall be required to comply with all Federal and Guam Laws and regulations applicable to the Bookmobile service.

II. IDEMNITY:

1. Each party agrees to save and hold harmless each other, its officers, agents, representatives, successors, and assigns and other Government of Guam agencies from any and all suits or actions of every nature and kind, which may be brought for or on account of any injury, death, or damage arising out of the other's negligent acts or omission under this agreement.

III. TERMINATION

This Agreement will expire in one (1) year, unless extended by both parties.

...All appointees to Boards and Commissions of the government of Guam shall be required to disclose and submit a financial report containing only information where conflicts of interest or possible conflicts of interest exist at the time of appointment or as may be expected to exist during their tenure of service on the Board or Commission to which they are being appointed. Such information shall include conflicts of interest or possible conflicts of interests with the appointee's or member's place of employment, any entity in which the appointee or member serves as a director or consultant to and any entity to which the appointee or member or a family member of the appointee or member owns an interest of five percent (5%) or more in... In the event that any conflicts of interests arise subsequent to a member's appointment, the member shall, within thirty (30) days of the knowledge of such conflicts of interest, file an amended report with the Guam Election Commission or by the next filing deadline, whichever is sooner...**In the event that no conflicts of interests or possible conflicts of interest exist, the report shall state that 'no conflict exists.'**... (4 GCA § 13104.1)

...Prior to any determination of the matter, the employee shall verbally disclose at the meeting, if any, the nature of such interest, and shall have such disclosure placed in the official records of the agency. Should an employee be absent from that meeting or a portion of that meeting, the employee is required to verbally disclose the nature of the conflict at the next attending meeting and said disclosure shall be placed in the official records of the agency. Further, the employee must complete a Disclosure of Conflicts of Interest form with the Guam Election Commission within three (3) working days upon the employee's recognition of said conflict. (4 GCA § 15205(g))

...Prior to any determination of the matter, the employee shall verbally disclose at the meeting, if any, the nature of such interest, and shall have such disclosure placed in the official records of the agency. Should an employee be absent from that meeting or a portion of that meeting, the employee is required to verbally disclose the nature of the conflict at the next attending meeting and said disclosure shall be placed in the official records of the agency. Further, the employee must complete a Disclosure of Conflicts of Interest form with the Guam Election Commission within three (3) working days upon the employee's recognition of said conflict. (4 GCA § 15205(g))
