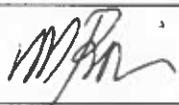
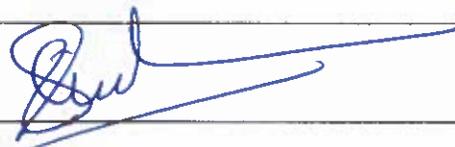
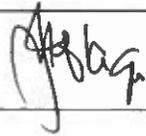

1 Call to Order

The meeting was called to order at 4.10 pm.

2. Determination of Quorum.

The meeting was called to order with a quorum of four present.

1. Voted: To table the minutes of May 18, 2023, at the next meeting.
2. Voted: To table to revisit the board manual at the next meeting.

Dr.Storie encouraged the board members to read the board manual and bring suggestions at the next meeting

3. Director's report. Director Kris Secrengan explained how GPLS was nominated as one of the 15 libraries to select three to be awarded as the Library of the Year. Bookmobile is still in the process of changing the ownership from Matson to GPLS as per the recommendations of the official of Revenue and Tax. Matson agreed to change the ownership to GPLS. Regarding other services, the foundation members are committed to serving as stipulated in the MOU. He requested the board to accept the donation from Matson.

4. Voted to accept the donation of the bookmobile unanimously.

Note. Dr. Storie questions who will be responsible for the insurance and who will fix it if the bookmobile meets an accident. The Director elaborated that once the property was transferred to GPLS, the government would be responsible for setting it. Matson will do the maintenance

He touched base on the Internet Café, which one of the government offices is temporarily using. Once they found a place, we prepared to open the Internet Café.

Library for the Blind and Print and Disabled. The director mentioned that the system would serve the public and other islands. Dr. Storie suggested that we must have an MOU from the other islands. Dr. Storie told us not to start the program until we place an MOU with the public libraries.

The director briefly mentioned Senator Perez's efforts to get funding for promoting literacy, and it did not happen. The Internet Café project is on hold because one of the government offices is temporarily vacant as their office is severely damaged.

The meeting was adjourned with the motion to adjourn.
